BOARD WORKSHOP HIGHLIGHTS

Appoint new BOD member – Steve Schneider was nominated to fill Sue Tinder’s position on the Board. The Board voted and this was approved 6-0.

Stay in TV – Respite Care – Marilyn Hawkey gave an update on STAYinTV and an overview of the Respite Care program. The program started in the fall and the goal is to provide relief for caregivers, as well as companionship for patients. In terms of community service, 101 hours have been completed thus far. Retail/Service Solicitation Program Update – Fred Toettcher gave a detailed update on the Retail/Service Solicitation Program, including the results from the survey. In total, there were 1,169 respondents and 907 respondents completed the survey (862 non-Kahite residents and 81 Kahite residents). The survey provides the foundation for a successful Tellico Village Business Alliance/“Shop Tellico Village” Program.
