Ray Mears Memorabilia Sale to Benefit Library

The sale of the Ray Mears Memorabilia Collection will be held 10 a.m.-1 p.m. Saturday, Jan. 26, at East Club Gate 26 of Neyland Stadium on the University of Tennessee Campus. There is no charge for admittance. Refreshments will be served. Dana Mears will be a special guest at the sale. The

memorabilia was donated to The Public Library at Tellico Village by Coach Mears' widow, Dana Mears, a resident of Tellico Village. All proceeds from the sale will benefit the library. The sale will precede the 2 p.m. Tennessee-Alabama basketball game. For more information, contact Rich Seymour purdue14@charter.net.

As coach of the University of Tennessee Basketball team, Mears' team won three SEC championships and had a school record of 278 wins. He compiled three Southeastern Conference championships between 1962 and 1977 and an overall winning percentage of .713. Mears was twice named the SEC Coach of the Year (1967 and 1977). He coached 12 All-Americans at Tennessee, including NBA stars Bernard King and Ernie Grunfeld. He retired in 1977 after 21 years of college coaching and a 399-135 record with no losing seasons and a .747 winning percentage. After leaving coaching, he served for 10 years as athletic director at the University of Tennessee at Martin. One of the prime achievements of Mears' tenure at Tennessee was the introduction of the phrase "Big Orange Country" to the Volunteer fans.
