Art Guild Meets March 21 Featuring Denise Stewart-Sanabria

The Art Guild of Tellico Village's monthly meeting will be 9:30 a.m. Thursday, March 21, on the top floor of Tellico Village Yacht Club. Guild members and guests are encouraged to attend. Proceedings include a meet-and-greet and brief business meeting prior to the featured presentation by artist Denise Stewart-Sanabria (www.stewart-sanabria.com).

Stewart-Sanabria is originally from Massachusetts, where she attended the School of the Worcester Art Museum before receiving her BFA in Painting from the University of Massachusetts Amherst. She has lived in Knoxville since 1986. Her hyper-realist still life paintings of jelly donuts and vibrant produce were recently featured in *International Artist* magazine. Also receiving national attention in the February 2013 issue of *American Art Collector* is Stewart-Sanabria's work in another medium: she creates full-scale charcoal on plywood portraits of people, using the life-size cutouts in conceptual installations.



Stewart-Sanabria's artwork is represented in solo, two-person, and group exhibitions and has garnered numerous awards and accolades. Recent exhibitions include *Continue: The Figurative Tradition in Contemporary Art* at Ewing Gallery at the University of Tennessee in Knoxville; *The 55th Mid-States Art Exhibition* at the Evansville Museum of Art (IN); *The American Still Life: Yesterday and Today* at The Bascom in Highlands (NC); *In the Flesh* at Target Gallery, Torpedo Factory Art Center in Alexandria (VA); *The 26th Tallahassee International* at the Florida State Museum of Fine Arts; *Red Clay Survey* at the Huntsville Museum of Art (AL), and the 2012 *Contemporary Realism Biennial* at the Fort Wayne Museum of Art (IN). In addition, Stewart-Sanabria writes visual arts exhibition reviews for *Number*, *Art Papers*, and *Nashville Arts Magazine*.
