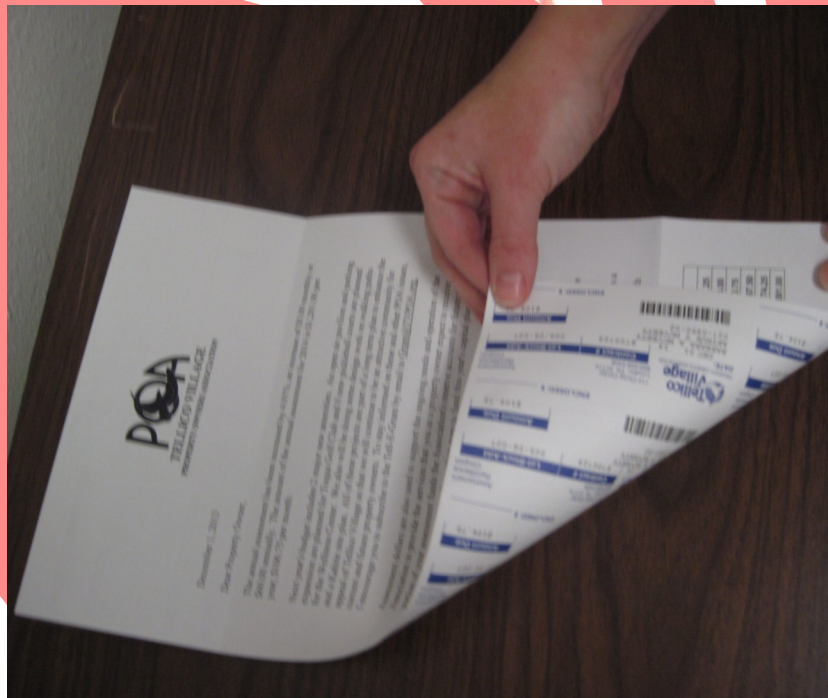

Chelsea 101

With anything new, brings in lots of questions. Here are some of the questions we have been getting the most and the answers to them.

1. I can't get into Chelsea. How do I log on?

Answer: Most of you have saved a link or made Chelsea a favorite on your computer. You will need to change or delete that link or favorite and make a new one. Open up an internet page and in the address bar (not the Google search) type tellicochelsea.com. This will bring you to the new Chelsea page and then you may make a saved link or add to your favorites. If the opening page to Chelsea does not appear, you are not typing www.tellicochelsea.com in the correct spot.

2. When can I make a Request and Booking?

Answer: Requests can be made 13-7 days out. The requests are now processed 12 hours earlier than before. For example, if you were wanting to play golf Tuesday Dec. 10, you will have to get your request in by midnight tonight. If you wait until Wednesday morning, it will already have become a Booking.

Bookings can be made six days out through 6 a.m. the day of. For example, if you are not feeling good on Sunday night and have a tee time Monday morning, you can go on Chelsea, edit your booking and delete yourself from the group and not have to call the shop the next morning. Please make sure you click "Add, Edit

or Delete a Player" and **NOT** "Delete a Booking". If you click Delete a Booking you will cancel the whole group.

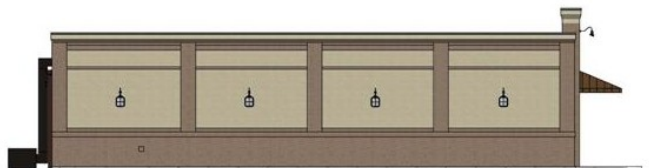
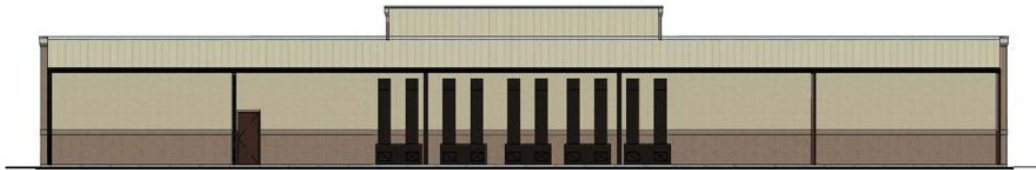
3. How do I use my buddy list?

Answer: Under your profile is where to make your buddy list. Once you have created your buddy list, make a new request, enter in your date, course, request time, preference, hole selection and number of tee times, then click Player Information. On this page you will see spaces for all your players. Using your buddy list place a check mark next to the name you want in that spot. Your buddy list is in alphabetical order so you will have scroll up and down the buddy list to make the pairing you want. Once you have all your players in, click submit, and emails and confirmation numbers will go out to your group.

4. How do I sign up for league play?

Answer: Under Request is "Add an Event Request." Pick the event you want to sign up for, then it will ask you what tees do you want to play from and on the bottom left you have to type in your POA number followed with a 1 or 2. Click submit and you are all set.

I hope this helps, and more will come. If you have any other questions please feel free to call any of the pro shops for help.
