Tellico Village University Celebrates First Day of Class

It was the first day of school—Tellico Village University is officially in business! Twenty Villagers attended the first day of the Introduction to Web Design class taught by Villager Tom Kowaleski. The course is the first of eight offered by TVU in their inaugural Spring 2015 semester.

The technology series includes other courses in web design, eBooks and e-Authoring, and photo editing to be offered later this year. In addition to these courses, the University offers other courses in French I, to be followed by French II later this summer; Disney Character Animation; Orchids; and an Introduction to Photography- an eight-week course that starts in May/June.

The series of health courses, all taught by health professionals, will feature Top Ten Nutrition Tips for Seniors taught by registered and licensed dietitian Linda Schuessler, and a Sleep Well class taught by Dr. Kevin Martinolich, MD, director of the University of Tennessee Medical Center Sleep Disorder Clinic. Self-publishing will be scheduled for some time in May.

TVU Director Cindy Solomon says the first day of school was a success! The overall response to this inaugural offering of courses has been very encouraging. The first two courses were filled to their limit. Classes may run for 1-2 hours for one week; and some may run for multiple weeks. Tuition is extremely low to enable more to attend while building funds to grow University offerings in the future. Registration is through the CONTACT US page on the site; a confirmation of registration will be sent to each registered student.
