There is a free emergency notification system service to all citizens of Loudon County operated by the Loudon County E-911 Center along with the Loudon County Emergency Management/Homeland Security Agency who have teamed up to provide a notification system to provide emergency alerts to citizens in times of natural or man-made disasters. Any Loudon County citizen can sign up to receive alerts via: text message, voice mail, email, mobile phone, and traditional landline phones. Potential notifications can include weather alerts, missing children, law enforcement events, and hazardous material events. As a reminder:

- Daily use of courtesy docks are on a first come, first serve basis.
- Courtesy slips will not be reserved (daily or overnight) for any special events or occasions, such as Tiki Bar nights or other Yacht Club functions, holidays, etc. Their use will be on a first come, first serve basis.
- Only property owners can reserve a courtesy slip for overnight use (with the exception of the above); the fee is \$5 per night for a maximum of 3 nights; proof of current boat insurance must be provided before reserving the slip.

The Kiwanis AmTryke Program

The Kiwanis AmTryke program was developed by Fred Wicht, President Elect of the Kiwanis Club of Tellico Village. AmTryke is a tricycle individually adapted for special needs children. “Each AmTryke is specifically adapted to the needs of a special child,” said Fred, “who may not even be ambulatory without the AmTryke.

“We have now provided about 30 AmTrykes to special needs children in our area,” he added. In the beginning, the AmTryke program was funded entirely by the Kiwanis Club of Tellico Village. “More recently, Malibu Boats generously funded the program.

“Last year, Kiwanis International Foundation gave the Kiwanis Club of Tellico Village a grant to continue the AmTryke program, nearly doubling the program for this fiscal year,” Fred said. “We are very grateful to Malibu Boats and the Kiwanis International Foundation for their support of this important program for special needs children.”

The AmTryke team at our Kiwanis Club includes Fred Wicht, Chairman, Rob Orkney, Dan Kuzdzal and Rich VanCampen.

Last month, the Kiwanis Club of Tellico Village presented its 30th AmTryke to Garrett Jablonski, a six-year-old boy diagnosed with Mucopolysaccharidosis, also called Sanfilippo Syndrome. Pictured with Garrett are his father Scott, his mother Kelli and his seven year old sister Dylan. Fred Wicht is on the left.

We will be exploring two of the newest trails to Enterprise South, Hawk's Ridge and Dogwood Ridge. This is an easy "walk in the park" on well maintained, wooded trails. Given the June heat, you will enjoy being shaded by trees and have easy terrain for nearly the entire hike. We will stop at a pond area in the middle of the park for lunch. The hike should take about 4 hours, including lunch.

Enterprise South Nature Park is a Hamilton County park which opened in 2010 for hiking, biking and walking. Prior to this, Enterprise South was a TNT manufacturing facility for WWII, the Korean War and the Vietnam War. TNT was stored in the domed concrete bunkers. As we hike through the grounds, we go around some of the 100 "magazines" in the park (Yes, they are empty – or so we were told.) After the hike you are encouraged to drive the 7.5 mile perimeter loop which provides public access to several bunkers. You may also want to bring mosquito repellent.

Hiking boots and hiking sticks are recommended. Driving directions will be provided the morning of the hike. Bring water and a trail lunch. Carpooling is recommended, passengers are asked to contribute \$6 to the driver to help cover gas, etc. For more information, go to www.TVHikers.com.
