### **Yacht Club to Suspend Liquor, Wine Service Temporarily**

For ten days beginning Saturday, Aug. 22, the Yacht Club will not be offering liquor or wine service due to a penalty levied by the State of Tennessee Alcohol Beverage Commission (ABC). The penalty period will run through Monday, Aug. 31. Beer service will still be available during this period. Beginning Tuesday, Sept. 1, the Yacht Club will resume full beverage service.

"I'm disappointed that we were unable to successfully appeal this ruling by the state ABC," said Andy Fox, owner and operator for AWE Hospitality, the contractor for food and beverage service for the Yacht Club. "We still maintain that the penalty was excessive and unwarranted, but we wanted to get it over with and move on."

The penalty is a result of an ABC sting in June where the ABC maintains that a member of the Yacht Club staff served alcohol to a minor who was working undercover for the ABC. AWE Hospitality refutes that charge.

"We have full faith and confidence in Andy Fox and his professional staff at the Yacht Club," said Winston Blazer, Tellico Village Property Owners Association General Manager. "I find it quite interesting that a restaurant in our kind of community has been targeted for multiple ABC stings in the last several months."

This ruling in no way affects beverage service at either Toqua or Tanasi Clubhouse restaurants. "AWE Hospitality regrets this inconvenience. We value our Villagers and their support," said Andy Fox.
