Quick Election Facts

These are some quick facts that many people have been asking about during our campaign season as we prepare for the 2016 POA Board Election.

- There are approximately 107 miles of roads in Tellico Village. These roads are owned and maintained by the Property Owners Association.
- There are approximately 120 miles of water and sewer line owned and maintained by the TVPOA. The Public Works team keeps a keen eye on these assets 24 hours a day, 365 days a year.
- The POA Administrative building at 112 Chota Center is owned by the TVPOA. There is no note or lease on that property.
- The governing documents for Tellico Village are easily accessible on the TVPOA website at <http://www.tellicovillagepoa.org/typoa/about-poa>. Scroll down the page a bit, and you will see links for the Covenants and Restrictions, By-Laws, Articles of Incorporation, etc.

Hopefully this will clear up questions Villagers have on these topics.

Election Information

- Over the next few days Villagers will receive a postcard from the POA reminding to be on the lookout for election materials in the mail.
- Just before Nov. 1, eligible voters will receive a letter from the POA with their unique login and password. The letter will also clearly identify where Villagers need to go on the Internet in order to vote. The letter also has instructions on how to obtain and submit a paper ballot should you desire to vote via that method.
- Polls open midnight on Nov. 1 and will remain open until noon on Thursday, Nov. 19.
- The election results will be revealed at the POA conference room at 2 p.m., Friday, Nov. 20 and immediately disseminated via all of our communications methods.
- The elected members will take their seats at the Dec. 16 Board meeting.

What happens to my paper ballot?

This is a question we get every election cycle. Paper ballots are available for the election. The instructions to obtain those will be in your letter you receive when the polls open. ALL paper ballots are to be sent to Votenet. The POA will not process paper ballots. If we receive one, the Election Administrator immediately sends it directly to Votenet for processing.
