### **Tennessee ID Services Coming to Tellico Village July 14-15**

The State of Tennessee offers a unique opportunity for Veterans called the "Highways for Heroes Program." Through this program, Tennesseans are able to take advantage of various identification services right in the comfort of their own community. No traveling to a nearby town to wait in line at the DMV.

On 9 a.m.-4 p.m. Thursday and Friday, July 14 and 15, the Tennessee mobile unit will be set up in the parking lot at the corner of Chota Road and Highway 444, immediately in front of the Lakeside Real Estate offices. The mobile unit travels the state to issue Veteran designated driver licenses and Commercial Driver Licenses (CDL) to eligible Veterans and Service Members.

Even though the program is designed to bring these services to Veterans, all Villagers are invited to participate. If you need a driver's license updated or handgun carry permit re-issued, here's your chance. For Veterans, be sure to bring: DD214 for information transfer to driver's license; card or letter with you for proof of service and Honorable Discharge. For others, be sure to bring: proof of identification and residence; Birth certificate; Utility bill; Insurance statement; Tax record; or anything with address confirming the address.

Auditions for the Tellico Community Players' October 2016 production *Camping With Henry and Tom* will be held from 4:30-6 p.m. Thursday, July 21; 5:30-7 p.m. Friday, July 22; and 10:30 a.m.-noon Saturday, July 23—at the Tellico Community Playhouse, 304 Lakeview Plaza (off Ritchie Road), Loudon, TN.

The comic/drama by Mark St. Germain, features four male roles: Henry Ford, industrialist, age 58; Warren G. Harding, 29<sup>th</sup> president of the U.S., age 56; Thomas Alva Edison, inventor, age 74; and Col. Edmund Starling, secret service man, age 35.

Rehearsal begins with a read-through on Thursday, Aug. 25 and then weekly rehearsals (Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday evenings) commencing on Aug. 29. Production dates are Oct. 13-15 and 20-23.

“This production should be the actor’s priority during this time period. Those auditioning are asked to bring their personal calendar with them in order to determine any conflicts prior to committing to the show,” said Debbie Mayberry, the play’s director.

In the audition, the actor will be asked to participate in a cold reading of selected cuttings from the script in front of the play’s executive production team. Announcement of the cast should be posted by Wednesday, July 27.

**The play:** In 1921, Henry Ford, Thomas Edison, and President Warren G. Harding took a camping trip together into the Maryland woods to escape civilization; what they couldn’t escape was each other. Inspired by an actual event, *Camping with Henry and Tom* is an exploration of friendship, politics and leadership; a comedic and dramatic clash of two great minds and one great heart of the 20th century.

“*Camping With Henry and Tom* is perfect for this political season,” said Mayberry. “The parallels between our current political scene and those of St. Germain’s 1921 America are incredible! After nearly a century, it just goes to show that the more things change, the more they stay the same!”
