That does not mean they aren't sweet and loving lap cats. It means they are uncomfortable or scared. Take the time to meet each cat. Pet them while they are still in their condo and let them get used to you for a few moments before you pick him/her up. Once you get them home and they feel secure all will be well.... All animals adopted are spayed or neutered, have age appropriate vaccination! They and are microchipped (with registration). Cats are litter box trained. \$40 adoption fee.
