Another Delay in the Change to Traffic Patterns

The Tennessee Department of Transportation (TDOT) has announced another delay in the making the traffic lane changes at the intersection of Highways 444 and 321. TDOT now anticipates making the change in mid-May. The additional delay is necessary because TDOT recently announced it would remove most of the X-Lite guardrail end terminals that were included in the original bridge construction contract specifications and replace them with an improved design. The TDOT said it made the decision after analyzing crash data. The HOA/POA TDOT Liaison Committee will provide more information as it becomes available.
