## **Statistics**

This was our busiest week this year. We had a total of 90, yes 90 animals dropped off at the shelter through Owner Surrender, Stray and Transfer from our Animal Control partners. We have 35 big dog kennels and a puppy house, so you can imagine our need for fosters and rescues, so thank you to those folks who opened their homes this week to help not only us but also help the dogs. We had 7 adoptions and were able to transfer 34 animals to rescue, including 10 felines.

If not for our small group of faithful volunteers and the small staff, we would not make it. Even with those folks, **we still need volunteers.** There are many things we need to do and cannot get to when we have 90 intakes, so anyone who has some free time to lend a hand would be welcome!

**Shelter needs:** Lots of scoopable/clumping cat litter (Tidy Cat), Paper Towels, Laundry detergent, copy paper, bleach, Q-tips, cotton balls, and Original blue Dawn-all cleaning & office supplies are always needed!

The Monroe County Animal Shelter is located at 170 Kefauver Lane in Madisonville (behind Wal-Mart). Please note new hours: Tuesday-Friday from 11-4:30 and Saturdays from 11-2. The shelter is closed to the public on Sunday and Monday.
