Join us on November 13th as we hike Big Ridge State Park. We will meet at 7:45 a.m. for an 8 a.m. departure at Chota Center (across from Marathon gas station & in parking lot of Lakeside Realty). The hike will be a loop. We will start on the Ghost House Trail and continue up Big Valley Trail. At the intersection with Dark Hollow trails, we will turn onto Dark Hollow East, following the trail for one mile to a fire pit and campsite area. We will then return on Dark Hollow East and continue onto Dark Hollow West to the Lake Trail, finishing at the paved road which will take us back to the Grist Mill. The hiking surface is generally smooth, not many tree roots or rocks. Some short steep sections on the Big Valley Trail. ### TELLICO VILLAGE HIKING CLUB

We will hike the Pogue Creek Loop Trail on Wednesday, November 15th. We are departing Chota Center at 7:30 a.m. The trails we are hiking are among the newest in the TN State Park system, having been completed in 2014 and 2016. They have a lot to offer: two beautiful overlooks, some arches, and numerous, very impressive rock walls. The original 1.75 mile Pogue Creek Loop Trail, half of which we traverse at the beginning of our hike and half at the end,

is relatively easy/moderate. But the Upper Canyon Trail (in and out totals 4.2miles) drops (at times, steeply) into the canyon, and then ascends to the peak on the opposite side, thus presenting a bit more challenging hike experience. The hike being just six miles, the elevation change, will hopefully be doable for most of our hikers. The Pogue Creek State Natural Area trailhead is located just two miles south of Pickett State Park. Because of the longer drive time, please note our 7:30 a.m. start time. 

Tesla is a two-year-old Pit/mix and was brought into the shelter by animal control with her two puppies. Her collar was embedded into her neck. Her previous owner had never bothered to loosen Tesla's collar as she grew bigger and that was the result. She had to be taken to the veterinarian to remove the collar. Her puppies were rescued and hopefully they will have a better start to life than their mom.

She is sweet, copper in color and healing well after medication, and on the mend. Now it is time for her to have a first chance with humans. Tesla is spayed, has age appropriate vaccinations and testing, and is microchipped (with registration).

If you are interested in adopting Tesla, contact the Monroe County Animal Shelter, located at 170 Kefauver Lane in Madisonville (behind Wal-Mart). Our hours are Tuesday-Friday from 11-4:30 and Saturdays from 11-2. The shelter is closed to the public on Sunday and Monday.
