## NOTICE FROM WATER (WATERSHED ASSOCIATION OF THE TELLICO RESERVOIR)

The Water Quality Improvement Committee (WQIC) of the Watershed Association of the Tellico Reservoir (WATeR) recently published an article discussing the quality of water near the mouth of large creeks flowing into the Tellico Reservoir after a heavy rainstorm. The reservoir has excellent recreational water suitable for water sports; however, several watersheds of creeks flowing directly into Tellico Reservoir are primarily agricultural land, much of which includes livestock grazing.

These streams have elevated concentrations of Escherichia coli (E.coli) bacteria because of runoff from these pastures and direct access to creek by livestock. The Tennessee Department of Environment and Conservation has classified many creeks flowing directly into the Tellico Reservoir as environmentally impaired. Fortunately, except during heavy rain events, these creeks do not have sufficient flow into the reservoir and the bacteria decompose quickly in the shallow water near the mouth of the creek.

Based on the analysis of data collected by WQIC, the committee advises that people should avoid water contact in the shallow water where polluted creeks enter the reservoir for three days following a heavy rain event. ## TRAFFIC DELAYS ON NEW BRIDGE

Starting Monday December 4th through Wednesday December 6th, the contractor for the Tennessee Department of Transportation will place flagmen on the new Highway 321 bridge over the Tennessee River. For those three days the flagmen will control one-way traffic across the bridge while a concrete median wall is poured.

The wall will be constructed on the Tellico Village side of the bridge. It will be 500 feet long and will connect to the existing median wall on the bridge. The contractor will attempt to avoid using flagmen during morning and evening rush hour times.

Please allow extra time to cross the bridge and drive carefully to protect the workers present.
