Some Other Stuff You Need to Know...

Angel Falls Overlook Hike

The Tellico Village Hiking Club will depart for Angel Falls Overlook 8 a.m. Wednesday, Oct. 21, from Cooper Visitors Center. Angel Falls Overlook (2-hour/100-mile drive) hike is 6.5 miles, rated moderate, and has an elevation gain of approximately 500 feet. The hike will providing scenic views and opportunities for photographs. The hike leader is Curt Sheldon, 865-458-8510 or curt_sheldon@bellsouth.net.

This trail is in the Big South Fork recreational Area. It is one of the most scenic in the Big South

Fork, with passages along rock faces and through boulders, past cascades, over footbridges, climbing to a dramatic finish. The first part of the hike is relatively easy and provides very scenic views of the woods, river and rock formations. At about 2.2 miles the trail leaves the river and begins the ascent to the overlook. This is the only strenuous part of the hike as the trail climbs about 300 feet in about .6 of a mile through switchbacks and rock steps and between boulders. At the top of the bluff the trail levels for the next .2 miles to the overlook.

Note: We will be doing the Angel Falls Overlook hike without having done a prehike. We could encounter unexpected conditions.

Hiking boots and hiking stick(s) are recommended. Bring ample water and a trail lunch.

Directions will be provided the morning of the hike. Carpooling is recommended and will be set up the morning of the hikes. Passengers are asked to contribute \$5 to the driver to help cover gas, etc.
