TVPOA Donates Outdated Computers to TAP

The Property Owners Association Information Technology Department recently donated several pieces of used computer equipment to the Technology Access Program (TAP), a committee of the Tellico Village Computer Users Club. From the parts it received, TAP was able to refurbish at least six complete operating systems and donate them to area schools and other child service organizations. The equipment became available following recent upgrades to many of the POA computers.

Since 2007, the TAP Committee has given 367 computers to organizations such as the Boys and Girls Club of Madison County, Loudon High School, Greenback School and others. According to TAP,

these computers benefit more than 600 children who otherwise would not have access to a computer.

TAP refurbishes and licenses each computer through Microsoft. Each system comes with Windows XP, Microsoft Office, a modem and Ethernet, printer, one ream of paper and ink cartridge.
