Public Hearing for Viskase Expansion Nov. 18

The Loudon County Air Quality Task Force (LCAQTF) and the Breathe Clean Air Action Team (BCAAT) have requested a public hearing on a construction permit application recently submitted to the State of Tennessee by the Viskase Corporation to expand its Loudon manufacturing facility. The company makes cellulosic casings that are used in processing and packaging hot dogs, sausage and other such meats.

The hearing will be held 6 p.m. Thursday, Nov. 18, in the Loudon County Court House Annex in Loudon.

According to the permit application, the plant expansion will add new equipment and modify existing equipment to:

- increase production capacity
- increase the efficiency of existing equipment
- maintain compliance with federal emission control standards

The company expects the expansion to result in about 50 new jobs.

The expansion is, however, expected to also result in increased emissions, thereby impacting air quality in Loudon County. Even though emissions are expected to remain under the *allowable* levels specified in the permit application, Loudon County remains one of comparatively few counties in the U. S. that is currently not in compliance with two federally mandated air-quality standards.

Interested parties are urged to attend this important hearing to learn more about the impact of this planned expansion
