Villagers Drawn to POA Lot Marketing Expo

The recently announced new POA Lot Marketing program drew a steady stream of Tellico Villagers to the Yacht Club last Wednesday. More than 150 villagers picked up materials and viewed the new POA Lot section on tellicovillage.org at the POA Lot Marketing Expo.

"We were delighted with the turnout and the interest shown in the quality, buildable lots we have to offer," said Mitzi Lane, POA administrator in charge of the program.

The new program features two major components: multi-year assessment waivers for POA members who purchase one of the POA lots and a "Move Your Friends to Tellico Village" promotion to entice residents to invite their friends and family members for a visit or POA-sponsored tour of the community.

POA members purchasing one of the lots in the program will receive a three-year assessment waiver. Detailed information on each lot is now found on tellicovillage.org in a new section labeled POA Lots including lot descriptions and specifications.

The Villager who generates the most visits to the Village and the Villager who is responsible for the most POA-sponsored tours each will receive the promotion's grand prize: "The Tellico Village Passport."

The award is valued at \$9,200 and literally will allow the winning Villagers an opportunity to live free in the community for a year. It includes:

Art Guild Meeting Sept. 20 Features Photographer

In the Camera Lens: Features Photographer Dennis Sabo

The Art Guild of Tellico Village's first monthly meeting of the season will be 9:30 a.m. Thursday, Sept. 20, the upper floor of Tellico Village Yacht Club. Guild members and guests are encouraged to attend. Proceedings include a meet-and-greet and brief business meeting prior to the featured presentation, by internationally acclaimed photographer Dennis Sabo (www.dsabophoto.com).

Sabo specializes in contemporary fine art abstract, landscape, and seascape imagery. Sabo honed his creative and compositional skills early in a photography career that initially kept him undersea more often than he was topside. His clients have included Canon, Hilton Hotels, MSNBC, NASA, NBC NOVA, Ocean Conservancy, Rand McNally and Shedd Aquarium-Chicago, with additional examples of his photography appearing in *Best Dives of the Caribbean*, *Blue Planet*, *Forbes*, *Living Southern Style*, *National Geographic Kids*, and *Reef Horizons*. Sabo's art has been publicly exhibited at Blowing Rocks Preserve (Hobe Sound, FL), Brevard Community College (Cocoa, FL), Emporium Gallery (Knoxville), Arts in the Airport Spring Exhibition 2011 (Knoxville), the National Juried Exhibition (Knoxville), Red Line Gallery (Farragut, TN), and the Dogwood Regional Fine Art Exhibition (Knoxville). Sabo is also a frequent lecturer and workshop instructor. Sabo said, "When I capture an image...it is my hope that it evokes an emotional experience for the viewer. Perhaps it is how the subject is bathed in light, perhaps it is the lines of the subject that draws you in, perhaps the colors, or simply it is an image that you enjoy viewing." In his presentation to the Guild, Sabo will highlight some of his award-winning images taken in exotic locales around the world. He will also illustrate how certain underwater applications and techniques can easily translate to great landscape and scenic photography.
