

Located in Big South Fork NRRA, this hike has a lot to offer, starting with the twin natural arches that we meet fairly early in the hike. We'll take time here for pictures. The trail also takes us to a very rustic, but operational hostel, remains of a homestead and family cemetery dating to 1863, and to several very large rock overhangs. The trail is generally well maintained with just a small amount of rock climbing near the rock walls. There are a couple of steep stairs to navigate as well. Due to the low water flowage at Slave Falls, some hikers may wish to only do the Twin Arches hike, which would shorten the total distance to 5.5 miles.

Dates for this third Tellico Community Players performance of 2019 are Thursday – Saturday, June 13 – 15 and Thursday – Sunday June 20–23. All shows begin at 7:30 p.m., except for the matinee Sunday, June 23, which begins at 1:30 p.m.

One of the most famous plays of the modern theatre, *The Glass Menagerie*, has been described as a drama of great tenderness, charm and beauty. In its initial opening in Chicago in 1944, the play was not expected to last long, but the critics loved it and gave it rave reviews. When it opened in New York in 1945, the cast received an unbeatable 25 curtain calls.

The play is introduced to the audience by Tom, the narrator and protagonist, as a play based on memory. Tom cautions the audience that what they see may not be precisely what happened. Amanda Wingfield, a faded Southern Belle of middle age, shares a dingy St. Louis apartment with her son, Tom, and his slightly older sister, Laura. In *The Glass Menagerie*, the themes of illusions and impossible dreams offer an escape from reality, but they cannot be sustained. The past informs the present, and the possibility of escaping the past is only an illusion.

James Fisher is directing, and Len Willis is producing The Glass Menagerie. Sponsor of the show is Warren Jackson, CPA.

#### EAST LAKESHORE HIKERS



#### **PET OF THE WEEK:**



Kittens, kittens, and more kittens. We have an unusually large assortment at the shelter, so come on down and have your pick of the litters. All of our animals are spayed or neutered before they leave the Monroe County Animal Shelter to help control this over-abundance of animals being born homeless.

But what about those left behind? We have seen a significant decrease in the number of puppies and kittens coming into the shelter over the past 15 years thanks to the SNAP (Spay Neuter Assistance Program) and the fact that no intact animals are adopted out of our shelter. However, we're not there yet. The numbers still are too great and your help is needed.

SNAP (Spay Neuter Assistance for Pets) offers free vouchers to qualifying families for a spay or neuter procedure at participating local veterinarians. The next voucher session will be held Saturday, June 15th at the Cora Veal Senior Center in Madisonville from 10-11 a.m. Vouchers are available to qualified Monroe County residents. If you are in another county, you can visit this webpage to find options close to you: <a href="http://www.spaytennessee.org">http://www.spaytennessee.org</a>. PPAW in Greenback also offers low-cost altering at their clinic for anyone who does not meet the voucher income or county qualifications. Take advantage of these no- or low-cost opportunities available. Be part of the solution!

All animals adopted are spayed or neutered, wormed, have age appropriate vaccinations and testing, and are microchipped with registration. Cats are litter box trained. \$50 adoption fee over 1 year old, \$60 under 1 year old.

The Monroe County Animal Shelter is located at 170 Kefauver Lane in Madisonville (behind Wal-Mart) and is open Tuesday – Friday from 11 – 4:30 and Saturdays from 11 – 2. The shelter is closed to the public on Sunday and Monday. Call 423-442-1015 and check out all available pets on our website at www. monroecountyfriendsofanimals.org. TN Monroe County Animal Shelter is the official Facebook page for the Monroe County Animal Shelter.
