• The POA is consulting with PSAC and engineering firm regarding plans to build a second water tank and its location. It will most likely be in the north end of the Village. A second tank will help but not completely relieve the stress on our water system. It has been recommended that we supplement with water from TASS, add additional booster pumps, and work with residents to adjust irrigation schedules.

Dog Park Relocation: Bruce Johnson

- Currently located on property owned by a bank; a sale is pending
- Potential buyer wants the dog park to remain on the property
- Scouting new land in the event re-location is necessary
- The POA is willing to assist the dog park should they need to relocate

- Toqua Café: Historically, Toqua served 25-40 people for breakfast. Lunch and dinner at Tanasi and YC are overtaxed; Toqua Café needs to prioritize lunch and dinner to relieve some of that stress as soon as possible. Breakfast will be served once the restaurant is fully staffed and trained.

The home on this lot was built too low, creating drainage issues that cause the backyard to flood during heavy rain. The homeowner used a saw to cut off the top of the tank to allow water to drain into. Among many potential dangers, this poses a huge threat for small children and animals; it would be very easy for your small grandchild or pet to accidentally fall in.



STAR TOUR -- SIZE AND SCALE OF THE UNIVERSE




A FREE presentation and telescope viewing at the Public Library at Tellico Village on September 28, 7:30 pm
