The Meeting was called to Order at 1:00.

The Chair ruled that a quorum was present

Minutes of the July 12 Meeting were reviewed, edited, and approved

The Committee discussed the status of Early Voting in Loudon and Monroe Counties. In the two days of Early Voting at the Chota Center some 900 Residents used the opportunity to cast ballots. Seven candidates set up information tents and most were occupied by the candidates themselves. Early Voting by Kahite Residents has been less robust.

The Chair referred to the Committee a memo she prepared for the Committee's Board liaison regarding parking availability at the Chota Center and included anecdotes of voters leaving in frustration without voting. The Liaison reported TV staff is discussing options for the August 4 election day.

The Committee discussed ideas, concepts and tone for the last pre-August 4 Tell-E-Gram message.

Anecdotes from Village residents regarding the election were discussed and the Committee approved developing a plan whereby members would identify and ask to appear in situ for brief GOTV messages to TV clubs prior to the November election.

The Committee was briefed on a recent meeting of the Loudon Solid Waste Commission. No action was called for.

The Committee was advised that research suggested at the July 12 Meeting on data collection of volunteerism efforts by Village & Kahite residents was progressing.

The Meeting was adjourned at 2:00
