August 23, 2022, Public Meeting

The Chair called the meeting to Order.

Attending: Lisa Chaloux(resident), Carla Johnson (HOA representative) & POA's Lisa McCray.

The Chair ruled that a quorum was present.

The Minutes of the August 9 meeting were reviewed and approved.

The Chair asked to be advised when Committee members intend to attend a community meeting and/or if their planned attendance is to be cancelled so that a replacement may be sought.

The Chair announced she was invited to provide the POA Board with a Report on the Committee's activities since her last Report. The Chair solicited from the Committee points they felt relevant to the Report.

The Chair solicited any further voting data, esp. about Kahite Voting turnout; observed the recent news reporting on the four (4) ballot questions scheduled to appear on the November 8 ballot; and suggested the Committee generate specific talking points as a part of its GOTV plan. The chair reminded the Committee that, while the Committee is permitted by the POA Board to endorse, the Committee has decided that its GOTV messaging will continue to be non-partisan.

The Committee discussed suggestions for GOTV communications prior to the November 8 General Election. Suggestions included requesting candidates for state and federal Office representing the Village and Kahite provide short paragraphs and/or videos describing what they have done to represent both neighborhoods, specifically and the publication of candidate campaign links, etc. The Chair entertained questions from the public concerning its GOTV program to date.

A report on the most recent Committee of 100 meeting was presented.

The Chair reminded those present that applications for the three expiring seats on the Committee were available.
