

TANASI RESTORATION COMMITTEE UPDATE 5-24-23

Paradym Studios held a Precedent Analysis with the Tanasi Restoration Committee on May 16th, they felt we needed the perspective of lady golfers and interior designers. In light of this, we held a second meeting on May 24th for those who missed the first meeting along with the added members.

A Precedent Analysis is used to look at current projects around the world that inspire or steer design decisions. This helps generate ideas and helps validate a proposed approach, assuring the building can be constructed and will operate as intended. Precedents are not limited to a period, style, or building type. The committee felt this exercise was very helpful in determining what designs we like and those we wanted to stay away from.

The committee agreed we wanted to pursue a modern traditional style, one that will use a more modern approach but will fit within Tellico Villages' landscape. The intent is to capitalize a lake view to the back and a golf view to the sides.

The next steps include rough sketches of ideas generated after the precedent analysis. The committee will meet again the first week in June. We have *tentatively* planned a Tanasi Town Hall Meeting on Thursday, June 29th at The Community Church of Tellico Village.
