We are so excited to announce that the Smoky Mountain Raptor Center will be releasing 2 Great Horned Owls, a male and a female that have bonded in our program and were raised and rehabilitated this year in our facility. They are being released together at the Toqua Golf Course Pavillion on Monday, December 17, 2019 at 4:30 pm.

Just prior to the release there will be about 15 minutes of discussion regarding these 2 owls and how Great Horned Owls are the only natural predators of skunks. As well as how 2 other owls released at Rarity Bay in 2016 eliminated their skunk problem.
